On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Karnataka has decided to issue a "No Objection Certificate" to the applicant for establishment of a new Ayurveda Medical College with an intake capacity of 100 seats in BAMS Degree Course.

It is certified that:-

- The applicant owns and manages a 100 bedded hospital, which was established in the year 2020.
- It is desirable of Ayurveda College in the public interest, with admission capacity of 100 seats.

- C) Establishment of Ayurveda College at Vijayanagara District, Rashmi Institute of Ayurveda Medical Science and Research Centre, Kudligi with admission capacity to 100 seats is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per norms of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine are available with the proposed Medical College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurveda College as per NCISM norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the NCISM/Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
